The exterior integument resembles Indian rubber, but is gelatinous and tender most so when fresh than now — Thickness 5-8th of an inch — colour slate-blackish, excepting about the under jaw — Under this is a strong dense yellow skin — Thickness 8th of an inch — Under this fat on the abdomen 8 inches — on the back supposed much thicker.
