themselves, we would further observe that about
90. (of the above 390) are not legal Inhabitants
of the Town, but are & many have been residents
for several years past, your Committee would
further state from inquiries they are led to believe
the inoculation may be Obtained for from 50 cts
to 75 cents for each one -
